


What's Included?



(Set) Left & Right Saddlebags



Seat Attachment
Webbing Straps (A)



Bottom Of Bag (Bag to Bag)
Securing Webbing Strap (B)




Frame Attachment
Webbing Straps (C)



Flat Plastic Strips (D)
(Bag inserts to improve bag rigidity)


How to Mount the Saddlebags



1

There are two "pockets" inside each bag.
Insert flat **plastic strips (D)** into each pocket to improve the bag's rigidity.
Repeat on the second saddlebag.




Lift the seat and attach **two seat attachment straps (A)** around the seat.


Secure the seat back in place.

3 **FITTING**


Attach the quick release buckles (on **attachment straps (A)**) to the top of the bags on either side of the bike.




Push the buckle through the holes in the flap



Loop the strap through the "D" ring




Snap buckles together




Buckles above flap


Secure the bag flaps by closing Velcro (hook and loop strips), one on top of the other, for added security.

Secure bags at bottom (front) using **frame attachment straps (C)**, back footrests are a good point to attach, close the quick release buckles, and adjusting straps as necessary.

Secure bag to bag (bottom rear of bags), using **quick release buckles with strap (B)**, and adjusting straps as necessary. In this case straps x 2 (C) will not be used.

Alternatively, rather than bag to bag, secure bags at back using **frame attachment straps (C)**. In this case, strap (B) will not be used.

Tips

- Ensure the bags are positioned with a **minimum clearance** of **2 inches** from the exhaust to prevent heat damage.
- For safety, ensure that the bag and straps **do not** make contact with the wheel or the chain/belt.
- The frame attachment straps **(C)** should be secured by threading the strap end through the loop and wrapping it around a suitable attachment point, such as the frame or footrest.
- **Saddlebag Supports** may be needed if your bike has a minimalist design (e.g., Can-Am Ryker, Ducati Diavel), or if you want to keep the bags away from hot exhaust/moving parts, or to help prevent sagging by providing extra structural support.

- Our saddlebags are designed for mounting on the pillion or rear seat. Installing them on a rack or other areas may be more challenging.
- For best results, install the bag with the reflective strips facing the rear of the bike. These strips enhance visibility, especially at night.
- If zippers are stiff, apply zipper lubricant or wax to improve smoothness.
